Collect

Because, when Your Only-Begotten appeared in substance of our flesh, He restored us to the new light of His Immortality.

First Sunday after Epiphany White

Collect

We beseech You mercifully to receive the prayers of Your people who call upon You, O Lord: Grant that they may both perceive and know what things they ought to do, and also that they may have grace and power faithfully to fulfill the same; through Jesus Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Epistle Rom. 12:1-5

I beseech you therefore, ... members one of another *in Jesus Christ our Lord.*

Gospel Lk 2:42-52

It came to pass, when Jesus was twelve years old, ... with God and man.

Second Sunday after Epiphany Green

Collect

Brethren, know ye not ... and that Rock was Christ.

Gospel

At that time, Jesus spoke to His Disciples this parable:
The kingdom of heaven ... but few chosen.

Sexagesima Sunday

Violet

Collect

O God, who sees that we do not put our trust in anything that we do: Mercifully grant that, by the protection of the Teacher of the Gentiles, we may be defended against all adversity; through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Epistle

II Cor 11:19–12:9

Brethren, ye suffer fools gladly, may rest upon me.

Gospel

Lk 8:4-15

At that time, when much people ... fruit with patience.

Quinquagesima Sunday

Violet

Collect

O Lord, Who taught us that what we do without charity is worthless: Send Your Holy Spirit down upon us and pour into our hearts the most excellent gift of charity, the very bond of peace and of all virtues, without which whoever lives is counted dead before You. Grant this for Your only Son Jesus Christ's sake. *Amen.*

Epistle

I Cor 13

Brethren, though I speak ... but the greatest of these is charity.

Gospel

Lk 18:31-43

At that time, Jesus took ... gave praise unto God.

Ash-Wednesday

Violet

After Sext, the prostrate themselves before the Altar and say the seven Penitential Psalms with the Anthem *Remember not, Lord, our offenses, not the offenses of our forefathers, neither take Thou vengeance of our sins and Glory be. As it was.* The Priest then says:

Lord, have mercy.
Christ, have mercy.
Lord, have mercy.

Our Father.

Turning to the east, on the Gospel side:
And lead us not into temptation:
But deliver us from evil.

O Lord, save Your servants and handmaids:
Who put their trust in You.

Send to them help, O Lord, from above:
And out of Zion defend them.

Turn again, O Lord, at the last:
And be gracious to Your servants.

Help us, O God, our Savior:
*And for the glory of Your Name, O Lord, deliver us,
and be merciful to our sins for Your Name's sake.*

O Lord, hear my prayer:
And let my cry come unto You.

The Lord be with you.
And also with you.

Let us pray.

O Lord, we beseech You, hear our prayers, and spare
all those who confess their sins to You: that they whose
consciences are accused by sin, by Your merciful
pardon may be absolved. Through Christ our Lord.
Amen.

Let us pray.

We beseech You, O Lord: Inspire Your servants with
saving grace, that their hearts, being melted by

plenteousness of tears, may be so softened and subdued that the working of Your anger may be turned away by a fitting satisfaction. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Let us pray.

Grant, we beseech You, O Lord our God, to these Your servants: that, by repentance they may be continually mindful of their purification; and that, to enable them more effectually to fulfill the same, the grace of Your presence may precede and follow them. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Let us pray.

Let Your compassion precede these Your servants, O Lord, we beseech You: that all their iniquities may be blotted out by Your speedy forgiveness. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Let us pray.

Be present, O Lord, at our supplications, and do not let the pitifulness of Your mercy be far from Your servants: Heal their wounds, and forgive their sins; that they, being separated from You by no iniquities, may ever hold fast to You, their Lord. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Let us pray.

O Lord, Who are not overcome by our transgression, but graciously accepts satisfaction: Look, we beseech You, upon Your servants who confess that they have grievously sinned against You; for You absolve offenses

and give pardon to sinners—You have said You would rather the repentance than the death of sinners. Grant, therefore, O Lord, to these Your servants: that they may keep unto You the vigil of penitence and, amending their ways, may give thanks for eternal joys bestowed on them by You. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Let us pray.

O God, of Whose pardon all men stand in need: Remember Your servants and Your handmaidens; and, although they are despoiled of virtue and have done amiss in many things through the deceitfulness and frailty of their mortal bodies, we beseech You, give pardon to those who confess, spare them who entreat; that they who by their own deserts are accused, by Your mercy, may be saved. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

The Priest turns to the People, stretches out his hand, and says over them:

We absolve you in the place of the Apostles, to whom the Lord has given the power of binding and loosing; and, so far as self-accusation pertains to you and remission to us, may Almighty God be to you life and health, and the gracious pardoner of all your sins; Who lives and reigns with His Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

The Priest goes to the Altar, turns to the east on the Epistle side, and blesses the ashes previously prepared:

Almighty and everlasting God, Who has compassion upon all men, and hates nothing which You have made, passing over the sins of men for their penitence; Who also succors them who are in necessity: Vouchsafe to

X bless and **X** sanctify these ashes, which for humility and holy religion's sake You appointed us, after the manner of the Ninevites, to bear on our heads, for the doing away of our offenses; and grant that by the invocation of Your holy Name, all those who have so borne them for the entreating of Your mercy may be found worthy to receive from You pardon of all their sins, and this day so to begin their holy fast. that on the day of the Resurrection they may be admitted to the holy Paschal Feast with purified minds, and at length receive eternal glory. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

The Priest sprinkles Holy Water on the ashes, then prays:
The Lord be with you.
And also with you.

Let us pray.

O God, Who desires not the death but penitence of sinners: Graciously look upon the frailty of our condition, and vouchsafe of Your loving-kindness to **X** bless and **X** sanctify these ashes, which in token of humility and for the obtaining of pardon, we have placed on our heads; that we whom You have advertised that we are ashes, and who know that we shall return to dust by reason of our depravity, may mercifully be counted worthy to obtain the pardon of all our sins, and the rewards promised anew on our repentance. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

The Priest places ashes on the heads of the Clergy and People, making the sign of the Cross and saying to each:
Remember, O man, that you are ashes, and to ashes shall you return. In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. *Amen.*

When the ashes have been distributed to all, the Priest says at the choir step:

The Lord be with you.

And also with you.

Let us pray.

O God, Who are justly angry, and mercifully forgives: Consider the tears of Your afflicted people, and graciously turn away Your wrathful indignation which they have righteously deserved. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Let us pray.

Grant to us, O Lord, we beseech You, so to enter upon Christian warfare with holy fast: that we who are about to fight against spiritual wickedness may be fortified by the aid of continence. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil; see lest he take of the tree of life, and eat and live for ever.

Cherubim and a flaming sword, which turned every way to keep the way of the tree of life.

In the sweat of your brow shall you eat bread, said the Lord to Adam; when you shall till the ground, it shall not give its fruit; thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to you.

Because you listened to your wife more than to Me, cursed is the ground in your work. It shall not.

Let us who have sinned in ignorance amend our lives, lest we be suddenly overtaken by the day of Death, and seek

space of repentance and find it not. Hear us, O Lord, and have mercy upon us, for we have sinned against You. *We have sinned with our fathers, and done wickedly; we have wrought iniquity. Hear us.*

Collect

Grant, we beseech You, O Lord, to Your faithful people: that they may both enter upon the holy solemnities of the fast with befitting reverence, and pass through them with peaceful devotion. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Lesson Joel 2:12-19

Thus says the Lord, Turn ye even to Me, ... a reproach among the heathen, says the Lord Almighty.

Gospel Mt 6:16-21

At that time, Jesus said to His Disciples, When ye fast, ... there will your heart be also.

Preface

Who, by the Fasting of the Body, restrains vice, lifts up the understanding and bestows the recompense of virtue; Through Christ our Lord, by Whom:

First Sunday in Lent Violet

Collect

O God, Who purifies Your Church by yearly observance of Lent: Grant to Your family that what they endeavor to obtain of You by fasting, they may follow up by good works. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Epistle II Cor 6:1-10

Brethren, we beseech you ... possessing all things.

Gospel Mt 4:1-11

At that time, was Jesus ... and ministered unto Him.

Second Sunday in Lent Violet

Collect

Almighty God, Who sees that we have no power of ourselves: Keep us both inwardly and outwardly; that we may be defended from all adversities which may happen to the body, and may be cleansed from all evil thoughts in the soul; through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Epistle I Thess 4:1-7

We beseech you, ... but unto holiness *in Christ Jesus our Lord.*

Gospel Mt 15:21-28

At that time, Jesus went thence, ... that very hour.

Third Sunday in Lent Violet

Collect

We beseech You, Almighty God: Look upon the hearty desires of Your humble servants, and stretch forth the right hand of Your Majesty, to be our defense; through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Epistle Eph 5:1-9

Brethren, be ye therefore followers ... and righteousness and truth.

Gospel Lk 11:14-28

At that time, Jesus was casting out a devil, ... the Word of God, and keep it.

Fourth Sunday in Lent Violet

Collect

Grant, we beseech You, Almighty God: that we, who for our evil deeds worthily deserve to be punished, by the comfort of Your grace, may be relieved. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen*.

Epistle Gal 4:22-31

Brethren, it is written, but of the free; *with which liberty Christ has made us free*.

Gospel Jn 6:1-14

At that time, Jesus went over the sea of Galilee, ... that should come into the world.

Fifth Sunday in Lent

Violet

Collect

We beseech You, Almighty God, mercifully to look upon this Your family: that by Your great goodness they may be governed and preserved evermore, both in body and soul; through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Epistle

Heb 9:11-15

Brethren, Christ being come ... of eternal inheritance, in Christ our Lord.

Gospel

Jn 8:46-59

At that time, Jesus said unto the multitude of the Jews and the chief priests, Which of you convinceth Me ... and went out of the temple.

Palm Sunday

Violet

Collect

Almighty and everlasting God, Who of Your tender love towards mankind, sent Your Son, our Savior Jesus Christ, to take upon Him our flesh, and to suffer death upon the Cross, that all mankind should follow the example of His great humility: Mercifully grant that we may both follow the example of His patience, and also be made partakers of His Resurrection; through the same Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Lesson Ex 15:27–16:10

In those days, the children of Israel came to Elim ...
appeared in the cloud.

Epistle Phil 2:5-11

Brethren, let this mind ... the glory of God the Father.

Gospel Mt 26–27

At that time, Jesus said unto His Disciples, ... sealing
the stone, and setting a watch.

Monday in Holy Week Violet

Collect

Grant, we beseech You, O Almighty God: that we who,
by reason of our weakness, faint under so many
adversities, may recover by the pleading Passion of
Your Only-Begotten Son, Who lives and reigns with
You and the Holy Spirit, one God, world without end.
Amen.

Lesson Isa 50:5-10

In those days, said Isaiah, The Lord God hath opened
mine ear, ... and stay upon *the Lord* his God.

Gospel Jn 12:1-36

Then Jesus, six days before the Passover, ... and did
hide Himself from them.

Prayer over the People

Help us, O God, our salvation: Grant that we may come with joy to the commemoration of these benefits, by which You have been pleased to redeem us. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Tuesday in Holy Week

Violet

Collect

O Almighty and everlasting God: Grant that we may so celebrate the mysteries of our Lord's Passion; that we may be found worthy to obtain pardon. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Lesson

Jer 11:18-20

In those days, said Jeremiah, O Lord, Thou hast given me knowledge ... for unto Thee have I revealed my cause, O Lord my God.

Gospel

Mk 14:1–15:46

At that time, after two days was the feast of the Passover, ... and rolled a stone unto the door of the sepulcher.

Prayer over the People

May Your mercy, O God, purify us from the corruption of the old man, and enable us to put on the new. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Wednesday in Holy Week

Violet

Collect

Grant, we beseech You, Almighty God: that we who are punished continually for our evil deeds, may be delivered by the Passion of Your Only-Begotten Son, Who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

Lesson

Isa 62:11–63:7

Thus says the Lord God, Say ye to the daughter of Sion ... according to all that the Lord our God hath bestowed on us.

Collect

O God, Who willed Your Son to suffer on the Cross, that You might drive away the power of the enemy: Grant that we Your servants, may obtain the grace of His Resurrection. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Lesson

Isa 53:1-10, 12

In those days said Isaiah, Who hath believed our report? ... the Lord shall prosper in His hand. Therefore will I divide Him a portion with the great, ... intercession for the transgressors, that they should not perish, says the Lord God Almighty.

Gospel

Lk 22:1 – 23:53

At that time, the feast of unleavened bread drew nigh, ... wherein never man before was laid.

Prayer over the People

O Lord, we beseech You: Behold this Your family, for which our Lord Jesus Christ was contented to be betrayed into the hands of wicked men, and to suffer death upon the Cross; Who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

Maundy Thursday

Violet

All kneeling, the seven Penitential Psalms are said with *Glory*, and then the Priest says:

Let us pray.

Be present, O Lord, at our supplications, and graciously listen to me, who specially stand in need of Your pity; and grant to me, whom not by election of merit, but by the gift of Your grace You have appointed to this ministry, confidence in fulfilling the duty You have laid upon me, and of Your loving kindness work in our ministration. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Let us pray.

O God, most gracious Creator and most compassionate Restorer of mankind, Who by the Blood of Your only Son has redeemed man, by the envy of the devil cast down from immortality, quicken these Your servants whom You desire in no way to die to You; and, as You do not leave them to stray, receive them when chastised. Let the sorrowful sighings of these Your servants, O Lord, we beseech You, move Your loving kindness. Heal their wounds, stretch out Your saving hand to them as they lie

before You. Let not Your Church be robbed of any part of her body; Let not Your flock suffer loss; Let not the enemy rejoice over the losses of Your family; Let not a second death have possession of those who were regenerated by the saving laver. Unto You, therefore, O Lord, we humbly offer our prayers; before You we pour forth the sorrows of our heart. Spare them that confess; by Your aid let them so weep over their sins in this mortal life: that, in the day of terrible judgment, they may escape the sentence of eternal damnation. Most holy Father, spare them the knowledge of the terrors of darkness, of wailing in flames; let them, returning from the error of their ways unto the path of righteousness, suffer no more mortal wounds, but let that which Your grace has bestowed on them, and the reformation which Your pity has worked in them, be made whole and entire, and abide in them for ever. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Let us pray.

O Lord, Holy Father, Almighty, everlasting God, Who has deigned to heal our wounds: We, Your humble priests, entirely desire that You of Your goodness incline Your ears to our prayers, and be moved by our confession and repentance. Forgive all our offenses, have mercy on the sins of the whole world: Grant to these Your servants, O Lord, pardon for punishment, joy for mourning, life for death; that they who at the mighty prospect of the heights of Heaven have sunk down from their confidence in Your compassion, may be counted worthy to attain to the blessings of the reward of Your peace, and to the gifts of Heaven. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

The Priest turns to the People, stretches out his hand, and says over them:

Ablution of the Altars

After the Mass is ended, the Clergy assemble to wash the Altars and perform the Maundy. The water is blessed in the usual way, privately, outside the choir. Wine and water are then poured on the Altars, beginning at the High Altar.

After the ablution of the Altars, all assemble in the parish hall, where the Gospel for the Day is read, followed by a sermon.

The Maundy

At the end of the sermon, the two Priests of highest rank wash the feet of all, one on each side, and then wash each other's feet. In the meantime, Anthems and Psalms are sung.

After the washing of the feet, the Priest says:
We wait for Your loving kindness, O God:
In the midst of Your temple.

You have charged:
That we should diligently keep Your commandments.

Behold, how good and joyful a thing it is:

Blessing of the Fire

The Lord be with you.

O Lord our God, Father Almighty, Unfailing Light, Maker of all lights: Hear us Your servants, and **X** bless this fire which is consecrated by Your sanctifying benediction. You Who lights every man that comes into this world: Enlighten the conscience of our hearts with the fire of Your love; that we, being inflamed by Your fire and, illuminated by Your light, the darkness of sin being expelled from our hearts, may by Your guidance be deemed fit to come to life eternal; and, as You made fire to shine for Your servant Moses by the pillar of fire going before him in the Red Sea, so enkindle our light, and let the candle which shall be lit ever remain blessed in honor of Your majesty; and let whoever shall bear light from it be illuminated by the light of spiritual grace. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

After Holy Water is sprinkled on the fire, the Priest says:
The Lord be with you.

O Lord, Holy Father, almighty, ever-living God: **X** bless and **X** sanctify this fire; which we, unworthy as we are, through the invocation of Your Only-Begotten Son our

Lord Jesus Christ, presume to **X** bless. Sanctify it with Your **X** blessing, most merciful Father, and grant that it may prevail for the profit of mankind. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Let us pray.

Go before us, we beseech You, O Lord, always, here and everywhere, with celestial light: that we may both discern with clear vision and worthily and effectually receive the mystery of which You have willed us to be partakers. Through Christ our Lord, Who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

Blessing of the Incense

I exorcise you, most unclean spirit, and every illusion of the enemy, in the Name of God the Father Almighty, and in the Name of Jesus Christ His Son, and in the power of the Holy Spirit: that You should depart and withdraw from this creature of frankincense or incense, together with all your fraud and malice; that this creature may be **X** sanctified in the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ; that all who taste, touch, or smell it may receive the virtue and aid of the Holy Spirit; st that wherever this incense or frankincense shall be, there you shall in no way dare to come near, nor presume to raise opposition; but, O unclean spirit, whoever you are, fly far from here and depart with all your subtlety, being adjured by the Name and power of God the Father Almighty, and His Son our Lord Jesus Christ, Who shall come in the Holy Spirit to judge the living and the dead, and you, the father of lies, and the world by fire. *Amen.*

Let us pray.

We beseech Your everlasting and most righteous loving-kindness, O Lord, Holy Father, almighty, ever-living God: that You will be pleased to **X** bless and **X** sanctify this species of frankincense or incense; that it may be an incense acceptable to Your majesty for a sweet savor. Let this species be **X** blessed by You, **X** sanctified by the invocation of Your Holy Name: that wherever its smoke shall reach, every kind of evil spirit may be cast out and put to flight, even as the incense of the fish's liver which the Archangel Raphael showed Your servant Tobias when he went to set Sarai free. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

Let us pray.

Let Your benediction. O Lord, descend upon this spirit of incense or frankincense, like that of which Your prophet David sang, saying, "Let my prayer be set forth in Your sight as incense": that every illusion of the enemy of mind and body may be put to flight by this smoke; that we may be, as the Apostle Paul says, a sweet savor to God. From the face of this incense or frankincense, let every assault of the devil flee away, as dust before the wind and smoke before the fire; and bestow this incense of sweet savor, most Holy Father, to abide forever for the work of Your Church; that, by mystic significance, the fragrant odor may show forth to us the sweetness of spiritual virtue. Therefore, Almighty God, we beseech You, by the powerful right hand of Your majesty, deign to **X** bless this creature compounded of a mixture of divers things; that, by virtue of Your Holy Name, wherever the smoke of its sweet scent shall be given forth, it

may miraculously prevail to put to flight all vain assaults of unclean spirits, and to drive away all diseases and restore health, and in most fragrant odor to come up into Your nostrils with perpetual sweetness. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

A censer is filled from the coals with incense and the new fire is censed. The taper on the wand alone is lighted from the same new fire, the other lights of the church being put out first.

Blessing of the Paschal Candle

Now let the angelic host of Heaven rejoice, let the Divine Mysteries be joyfully celebrated and, for the victory of so great a King, let the trumpet of salvation be sounded. Let the earth, brightened with such effulgence, delight herself; and, being illumined by the splendor of the eternal King, perceive the darkness of the universe to be done away. Let our Mother Church also be joyful, adorned with the radiance of so great light, and let this house resound with the mighty voices of the peoples.

Therefore, as you stand by, most dearly beloved brethren, as the so marvelous clearness of this holy light, I pray you, together with me, invoke the tender mercy of Almighty God: that He Who has deigned to enroll me not for my own deserts in the number of Levites, pouring out upon me the grace of His light, may enable me to declare the praise of this taper. Through our Lord Jesus Christ His Son, Who with Him lives and reigns in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

The Lord be with you.
And also with you.
Lift up your hearts.
We lift them to the Lord.
Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
It is fitting and right to give Him thanks and praise.

Because it is very fitting and right to proclaim with full desire of heart and mind and voice the invisible God Almighty, the Father, and His Only-Begotten Son, with the Holy Spirit; Who for us paid the debt of Adam to the eternal Father, and blotted out the bond of the old sin in His holy Blood.

For this is the Paschal Feast, in which that true Lamb is slain and, by His Blood, the door-posts are hallowed. This is the night on which You made our fathers, the children of Israel, who You brought out of Egypt, pass through the Red Sea dry-shod. This, therefore, is the night in which the shades of sin were cleared away by the illumination of the pillar. This is the night in which Christ burst the bonds of death and ascended, conquering the grave. For it was of no advantage for us to be born without being redeemed.

O marvelous condescension of Your loving-kindness concerning us! O Unspeakable tenderness of Love! to redeem the servant You gave up the Son! O truly needful sin of Adam and of ourselves, which was blotted out by the Death of Christ! O happy guilt, the desert of which was to gain such and so great a Redeemer! O truly blessed night, which alone was permitted to know the time and the hour on which Christ rose from the grave!

This is the night of which it is written, "The night is as clear as the day"; and, "My night shall be turned to day." Therefore, the hallowing of this night put to flight wickedness, washes away guilt, restores innocency to the fallen, and joy to the sorrowing: banishes hatred, brings about concord, and bows down sovereignties.

Therefore, in favor of this night: Receive, Holy Father,

Grains of incense are put into the the candle in the form of a Cross, and into the branch.

the evening sacrifice of this incense, which the Holy Church offers to You in this solemn oblation of wax, the work of bees, at the hands of the ministers.

But now we have heard the praise of this pillar which, in honor of God, the glowing fire kindles.

The candle is lit from the new fire and not put out until Compline the next day, and the other candles throughout the church are lit from it.

Which, although it is divided into parts of borrowed light, has suffered no loss. It is fed by the liquid wax which the Queen Bee produced for the composition of this precious taper.

O blessed night, which spoiled the Egyptians, enriched the Hebrews: night in which heavenly things are united with earthly.

We pray You, O Lord, that this candle, consecrated to the honor of Your Name, may last unfailling for the dispelling of the darkness of this night. Being acceptable for its sweet odor, let it be mingled with the lights above.

Let the Morning Star find it burning; that Morning Star
Who knows no setting; He Who returned from the grave,
and shone serene upon mankind.

We therefore pray, O Lord, that You will grant us
quietness of times, and be pleased to preserve in
these paschal joys us Your servants, all the clergy
and most devout people, together with our Patriarch,
N, and our Bishop, *N*.

Who lives and reigns, rules, and are gloried, God
alone, alone most high, Jesus Christ, with the Holy
Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. *Amen*.

Blessing of the Font

The Lord be with you.
And also with you.
Let us pray.

Almighty, everlasting God, be present at the
mysteries of Your exceeding goodness, be present at
the Sacraments, and for the regenerating of the new
people which the font of Baptism brings forth for You:
Send out the Spirit of Adoption, that whatever is here
done by our humble ministry may be fulfilled by the
effectual working of Your virtue. Through our Lord
Jesus Christ, Your Son, Who lives and reigns with
You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, world
without end. *Amen*.

The Lord be with you.

Lift up your hearts.
We lift them to the Lord.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
It is fitting and right to give Him thanks and praise.

It is very fitting, right, and our bounden duty to at all times and in all places give thanks to You, O Lord, Holy Father, Almighty, everlasting God, Who most wonderfully and effectually work in the invisible power of Your sacraments. And although we are unworthy to discharge so great mysteries, yet You do not leave us destitute of Your gifts of grace, and incline Your merciful ears to our prayers.

O God, Whose Spirit moved upon the face of the waters amidst the very first elements of the world, that even then nature might take into herself the sanctification of the waters; O God, Who by washing away the crimes of the guilty world in water foreshadowed the figure of regeneration in the very outpouring of the Deluge, that the mystery of one and the same element might be both the end of vice and the source of virtue: Look down, we beseech You, O Lord, on the face of Your Church, and increase and multiply in her Your regenerated people, You Who by the mighty power of Your abundant grace gladdens Your city and opens the font of Baptism for the calling in of the Gentiles throughout the whole world; that at the command of Your Majesty it may receive the grace of Your Only-Begotten of the Holy Spirit.

The Priest divides the water with his hand in the form of a Cross, saying:
May He fertilize this water prepared for the regeneration of man by the hidden intermixture of His light: that, by a holy conception, a heavenly offspring may rise up out of the spotless womb of the divine font into a new-born

creature. And grant all who differ in sex or age be brought forth by parent grace to the same infancy. Therefore, at Your command, O Lord: Let every unclean spirit depart far from here; Let the whole malice and fraud of the devil stand far away. Let no power of the enemy intrude and find place here, nor haunt or lie in wait around, nor creep in surreptitiously, nor infect with poison.

Let this creature be holy and innocent, free from all assault of the adversary and purified by the abolishing of all wickedness. Let it be a living **X** font, a regenerating **X** water, a purifying **X** stream: that all those who are to be washed in this laver of salvation, through the operation in them of the Holy Spirit, may obtain the favor of perfect purification.

Therefore, I bless you, O creature of water, by the living **X** God, by the true **X** God, by the holy **X** God, by **X** God Who in the beginning divided you by His word from the dry land, Whose Spirit moved upon you, Who caused you to flow out of Paradise, and commanded you to water the earth in four rivers.

The Priest throws water out of the font with his hand in the form of the Cross into the four quarters.

Who, when you were bitter in the desert, poured sweetness into you and made you fit to drink; and brought you forth out of the rock for the people who were thirsty.

I **X** bless you by Jesus Christ His only Son our Lord, Who in Cana of Galilee turned you into wine by His powerful sign and miracle; Who walked upon you with His feet and was baptized in you by John in Jordan;

Who brought you forth out of His side together with blood, and commanded His Disciples to baptize believers in you, saying, "Go teach all nations, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

O God, almighty and merciful: be present with us who keep these commandments; graciously breathe upon us.

The Priest breathes three times on the font in the form of the Cross:
X Bless these pure waters with Your mouth: that, over and above the natural cleansing power they may exercise over bodies washed in them, they may be effectual to the purifying of souls.

The Priest lets drops of wax fall from the candle into the font in the form of a Cross and then says:
Let the power of the Holy Spirit descend into this font and make the whole body of this water fruitful in regenerating power:

The Priest dips the candle into the middle of the font, making a Cross, and then continues:

Here let the stains of all sin be done away; Here let nature, formed after Your image, and reformed for the honor of its Author, be cleansed from all the filthiness of the old man.

The Priest takes the candle out of the font, saying:
That every man who approaches this sacrament of regeneration may be born again into the new infancy of true innocency. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Your Son, Who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, world without end. *Amen.*

Collect

O God, Who enlightens this most holy night with the glory of the Lord's Resurrection: Keep in the children of Your new family the spirit of adoption which You have given; that they, being renewed in body and mind, may offer to You a pure service. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*
